- I. **Academic Performance: The Yellow Springs Schools will meet all state performance standards and local quality standards.**
 - a. Review state performance and district data and identify areas of improvement. X
 - b. Assess intervention/improvement strategies implemented to meet 2004-2005 standards. X
 - c. Identify and implement strategies to meet 2005-2006 standards including: proficiency tests, achievement tests, the Ohio Graduation Test, graduation rate and attendance. X
 - d. Assess strategies based on performance data on the 2006 State Report Card. X
 - e. Implement local quality standards. X
 - f. Assess district performance based on local quality standards. X

- II. **Curriculum and Instruction: The Yellow Springs Schools will review, revise, develop, and implement curricula to meet the instructional needs of each student.**
 - a. Develop textbook study, selection and purchase timelines grades K-12. X
 - b. Begin science curriculum review and revision grades 7-12. X
 - c. Implement three year Mathematics Initiative including strategies to investigate, share, implement and assess best practice. X
 - d. Include professional development in the area of differentiation of instruction as part of the formal professional in-service program. X

- III. **School Climate and Structure: The Yellow Springs Schools will assess school climate and structure and implement program and structural initiatives that reflect the mission of the schools and the values of the district and community.**
 - a. Implement new K-12 school day schedule, if approved. X
 - b. Continue anti-bullying programs and collect data and continue to use rubrics at MLS. X
 - c. Strengthen the membership and participation in the McKinney and Yellow Springs High School PTO's. X
 - d. Implement the McKinney Project II to review and possibly revise the structure and climate of McKinney Middle School. X
 - e. Study and make a recommendation concerning continued North Central Association accreditation. X

- f. Gather data regarding student engagement in McKinney Middle School and Yellow Springs High School. X
- g. Increase and enhance opportunities for student participation in school climate initiatives, including School Pulse meetings under the auspices of the YSHS Student Review Board. X

IV. Technology: Technology will be implemented to support student learning objectives and the administrative functions of the schools.

- a. New network switches will be installed at YSHS and the Board Office. X
- b. Video broadcasting technology will be operational at MLS and YSHS. X
- c. Special Education software fully operational by start of 2005-2006 school year. X

V. Facilities and Transportation: The Yellow Springs Schools will improve and maintain facilities and transportation capabilities that support and enhance instructional and extracurricular programs for each student.

- a. Construction of a district multipurpose facility in place of the current bus barn. X
