It provides a peaceful atmosphere that includes restful bedrooms, a grocery stocked kitchen, a laundry room, and comfortable family rooms. Regardless of their ability to pay, families stay at the Ronald McDonald House free of charge.

The House receives salvage value for the [aluminum tabs](#) that can be found on various beverages, soup, pet food, and other canned items. Only the tabs are collected because they take up less space, are cleaner than the cans and are of higher quality aluminum.
