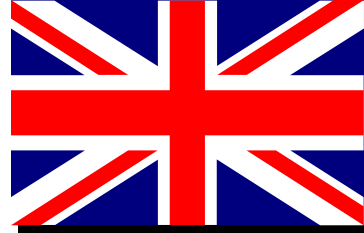
Who really owns the Rosetta Stone?

_____1. Do Internet research using the [Rosetta Stone Web Resources](#) listed (and others) to gather information about:

- When the text of the Rosetta Stone was written and why it was written.
- What the Rosetta Stone says. Remember, the text of the stone is a decree honoring the pharaoh Ptolemy V. Be sure to include some information about Ptolemy V, explain, in general what the text of the stone is about, and gather some quotes to use in your presentation.
- The importance of the Rosetta Stone. Explain why the stone and its translation were so important to our understanding of Ancient Egypt.

_____2. Develop your presentation for the International Tribunal. It will include the information gathered in 1 above. Remember, you will also try to persuade them that Britain is the rightful owner of the Rosetta Stone and that it should remain in the British Museum.

_____3. Create a PowerPoint presentation that includes text and pictures (clip art and/or photos). Your group will use this PowerPoint slideshow during your presentation to the Tribunal. The PowerPoint presentation will include information from 1 and 2 above.

_____4. Present your information, opinions, and PowerPoint slideshow to the Tribunal. Your goal is to inform them about the information you gathered during your research and to persuade them that Britain is the rightful owner of the Rosetta Stone.
